Bellco Glass Specification Sheet:

A Bellco Glass Specification Sheet is a controlled document that gives the end user an overview of the product and the materials from which it is manufactured. The goal of our specification sheet is to give the customer enough information and the expertise necessary to make a decision of the product for their application or usage. The information contained in these specification sheets we believe is correct to the best of our knowledge. The recommendations and suggestions herein are made without guarantee or representation as to results. We recommend that adequate tests be made in your laboratory or plant to determine if this product meets all of your requirements.

Certificate of Compliance or Conformity:

This is a statement or determination that the goods or service conforms to a law, standard, rule, guideline or other. Sometimes the certificate will refer to an internal standard, one not used in our industry or one that is not an acceptable standard. The goal is to get the documentation that adheres to the standards we & our customers want & agree to; 21 CFR, CE, & others.

Material Certificate:

This is a document that will define the material & composition. It should, for our needs, refer to an industry standard. For example, a certificate of 316L stainless steel will note the alloy composition & the ASTM or AISI or other standards for the material. A material certificate is given for material that has been tested & adheres to a standard.

Calibration Charts:

This is a step by step document to show the customer had to re-calibrate Bellco Equipment for validation purposes or if the factory set design parameters need to match design specifications after a repair. For example, re-calibrating Bellco Roll-In Incubators for temperature parameters or re-programming Bellco Process Control Bell-ennium™ Magnetic Stirrers.

MSDS Sheets: (Material Safety Data Sheets)

The United States Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) requires all manufactures to issue Material Safety Data Sheets (also known as MSDS's) with the shipment of any hazardous chemical product. The purpose of the MSDS is to relay important information about the nature of the chemical – such as its flammability, toxicity, the need for protective equipment, and spill or clean up requirements – to ensure the safety of any potential user of that chemical.
